Chili Cook-off in Cocoa Village – Ocala show and lack of volunteers resulted in decision not to participate.

CAT/FCAT – Marsha and Rip Dyal – Brenda Warner – property has been measured and would support a CAT event. Dates are set for February 22nd and 23rd of 2020. Megan and Emee have been contacted and are agreeable to these dates. Will look for a date to hold a Fast CAT. Joan advised Tractor Supply has spiked fence posts for the FCAT fencing. Marsha Dyal read a thank you from the officers the club sponsored at Old Dominion training camp.


Brenda Warner requested a handling class for Juniors only.


